In this varied and changemaking role, you will be responsible for delivering engaging and impactful workshops, training sessions and events designed to empower and inspire young people and young adults. This role offers an exciting opportunity to make a positive impact in the youth development of individuals across the West Midlands and contribute to the success of our youth centric 1 to 1, group based and social outreach initiatives.

Please note that travel is essential in this role, and candidates should be willing to travel or have their own transportation.

Responsibilities:

1. Programme Delivery:

- Facilitate, design, and deliver interactive and engaging workshops, training sessions, and events tailored to the needs and interests of our young people's needs.
- Create a supportive and inclusive environment that encourages active participation, collaboration, and personal growth.

2. Youth Recruitment and Engagement:



- Develop and implement strategies to recruit young people onto our programmes, including outreach efforts, partnerships with schools and community organisations, and social media campaigns.
- Build relationships with youth participants, understanding their needs and interests, and providing guidance on programme offerings.
